## HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

The Mazda Apprentice Program is a blended learning program delivered at a Mazda Training Centre in 1 week blocks supported by virtual classroom sessions in years 1 and 2.

Online Virtual Classroom (4 hour sessions):

**1st year - 15 online sessions**

**2nd year - 6 online sessions**

Face-to-face Training:

**1st year 6 weeks/blocks**

**2nd year 7 weeks/blocks**

**3rd year 8 weeks/blocks**

The face-to-face component of training includes access to a Mazda automotive workshop for practical components of the course. As a requirement of this course students will also have access to all the required equipment and facilities of a Mazda workshop.

Apprentices are selected for the Mazda Apprentice Training program after they have been nominated by a Mazda Dealership.
